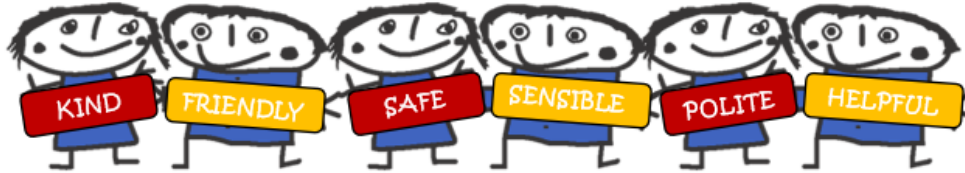

Areas of learning

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

During this term the children will be focusing on:

- Following the Nursery rules and routines.
- Establishing relationships with the staff and their peers.
- Developing their confidence and independence.

Communication and Language

This term the children will be learning to:

- Listen with interest to stories.
- Join in with stories and rhymes.
- Sing a few familiar songs.

Physical Development

This term the children will be learning to:

- Climb confidently and begin to pull themselves up onto the Nursery's climbing equipment.
- Ride the bikes and scooters confidently around the Nursery outdoor area.
- Use pencils, paint, chalk and other resources to make marks.
- Be more independent in meeting their own care needs, e.g. using the toilet and washing and drying their hands.

Literacy

During this term the children will be learning to:

- Handle books carefully and independently.
- Hold a book the correct way and turn the pages.
- Begin to talk about their favourite stories.
- Begin to give meaning to the marks they make.

Mathematics

This term the children will be learning to:

- Count to 10.
- Learning the Number Puppies 1 to 10.
- Use number names while they play.
- Recognise the shapes circle, square, triangle, rectangle.
- Use language to describe patterns around them, e.g. pointy, spotty, blobs etc.

Understanding the World

The children will be learning to:

- Use the iPads to choose an app independently..
- Take photographs using the iPads.
- Explore the outdoor Nursery environment and talk about what they can see.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be learning to:

- Join in singing Nursery Rhymes.
- Identify the colours they are using whilst painting.
- Explore what happens when they mix colours.
- Use their imagination to begin to engage in role-play areas.

Have fun together and learning at home, you could...

- Practise counting with your child.
- Help your child to recognise 2D shapes and the numbers 1-10.
- Help your child to recognise colours.
- Encourage your child to make marks on paper using pencils, crayons and paint.
- Talk to your child about what they are writing or drawing.
- Share a book with your child everyday.
