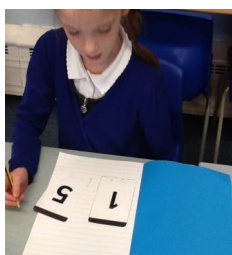
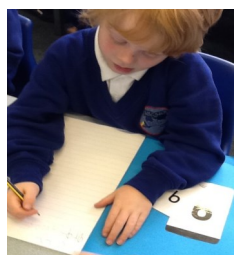
Reception (Classes 1 & 2)
