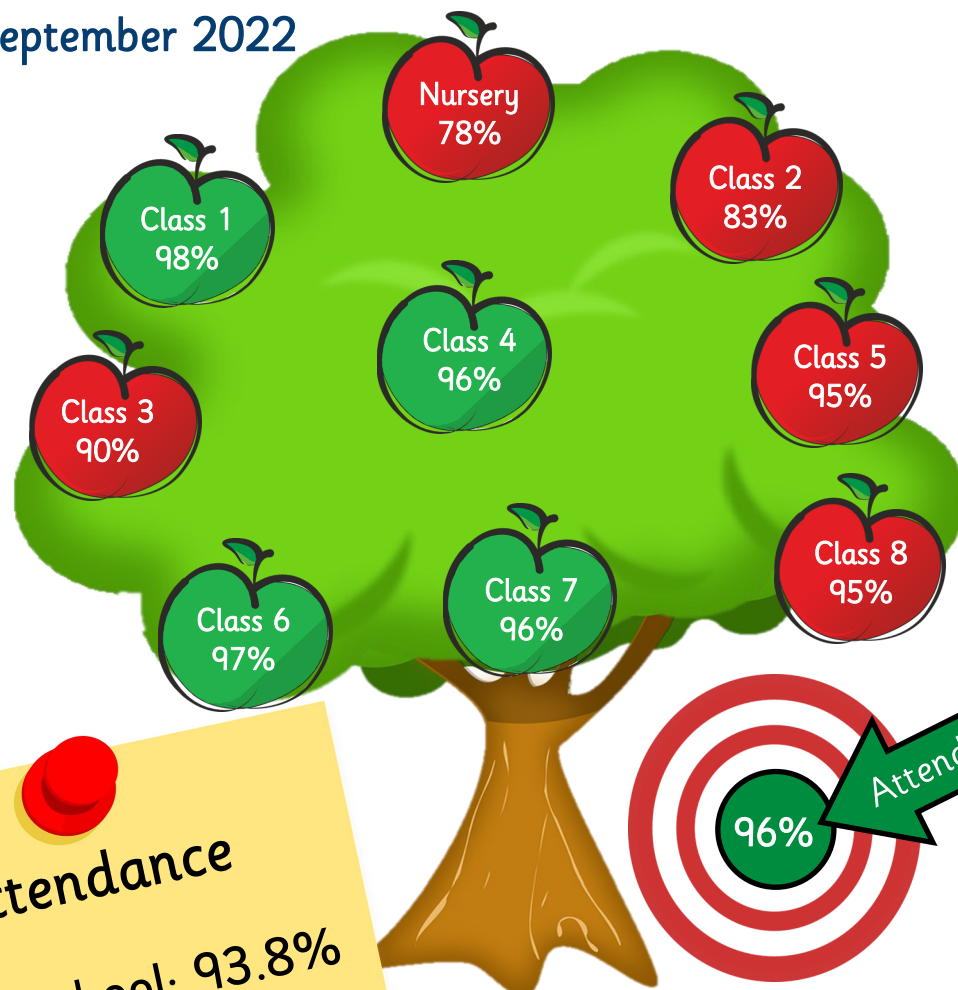




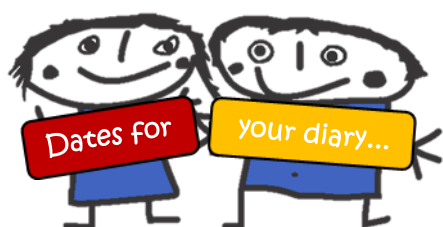
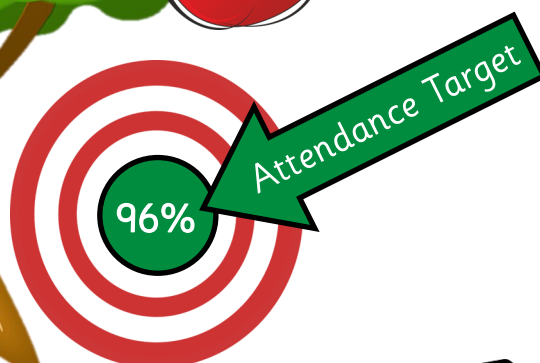

Reception (Classes 1 & 2)

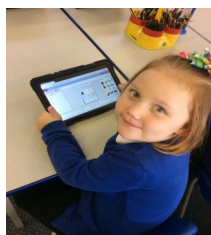
The children in Reception absolutely loved learning all about the different dinosaurs from the amazing 'Dinosaur Experience' this week.
