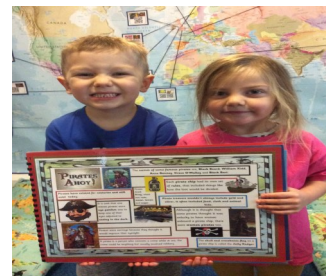
Nursery

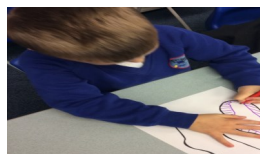
Reception (Classes 1 & 2)

Year 1 (Classes 3, 4 & 5)

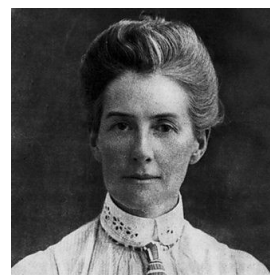
