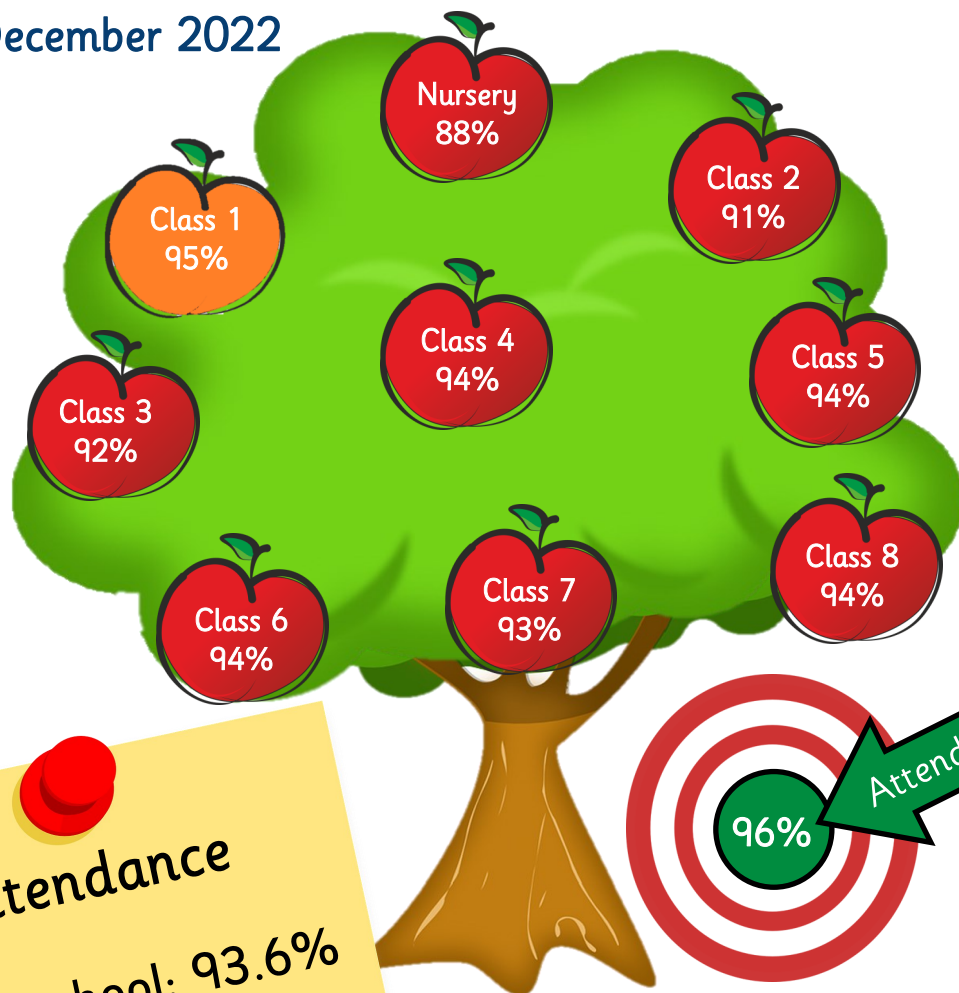




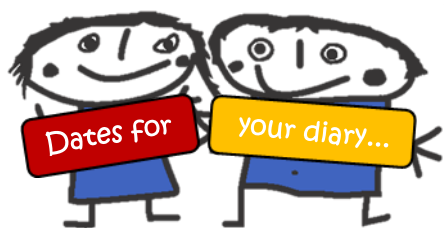
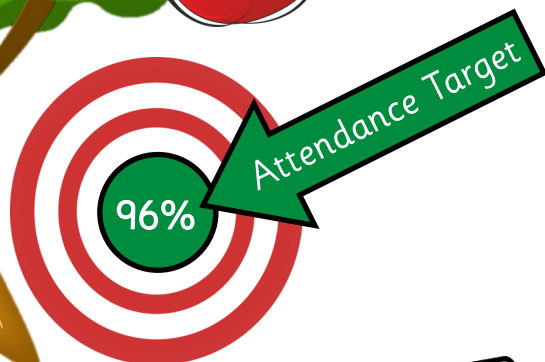

This week in Reception the children have created their very own precious pirate jewellery beads! They made them from clay, then painted them and enjoyed them very carefully. Amazing work everyone!



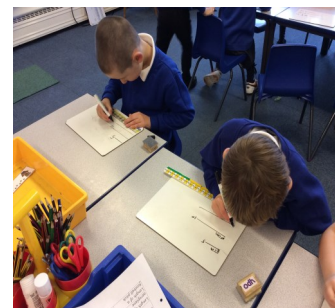
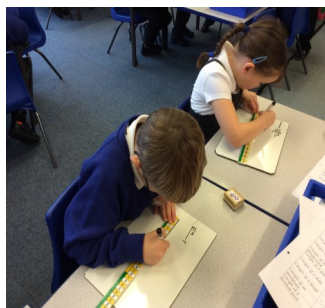
Year 1 (Classes 3, 4 & 5)
