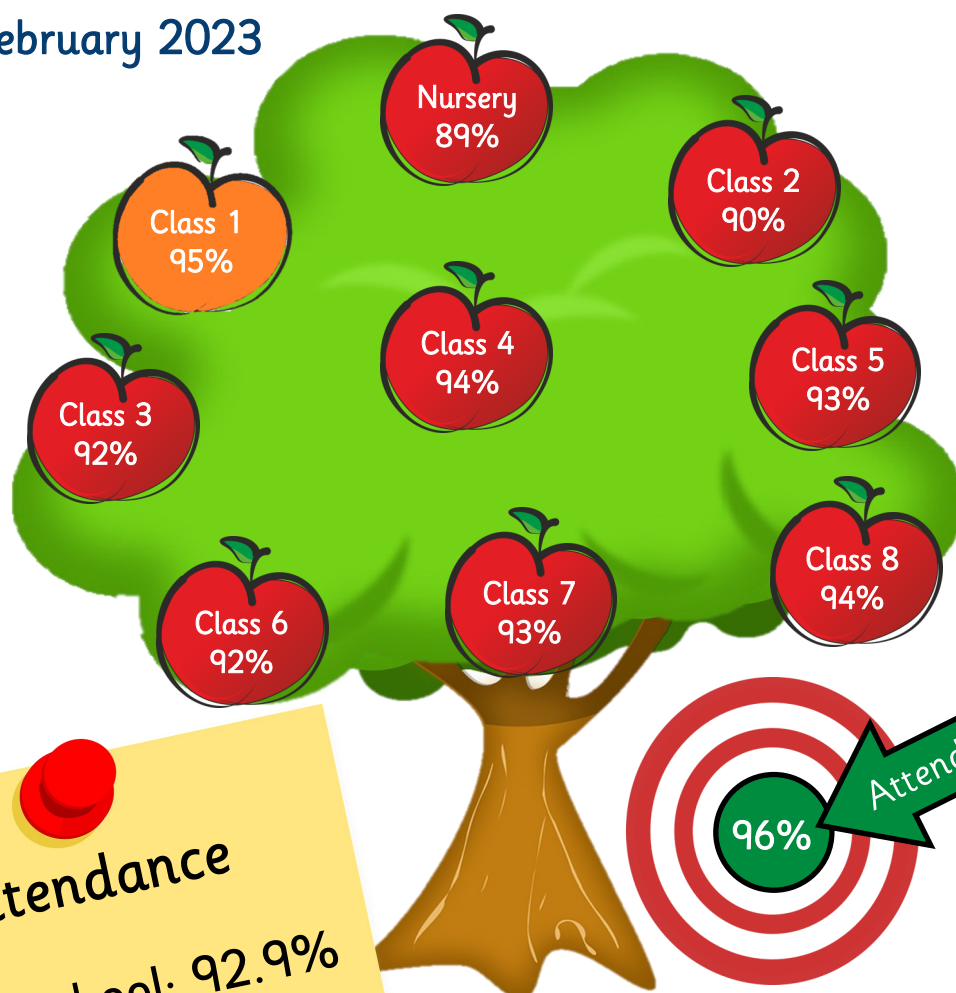




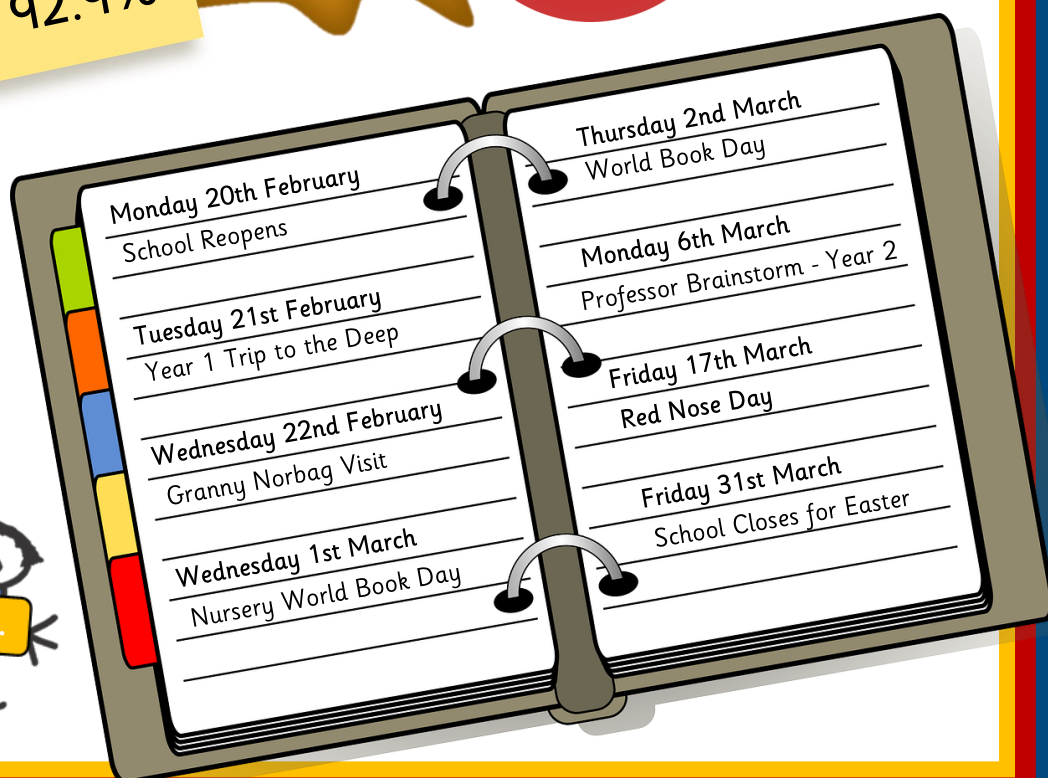
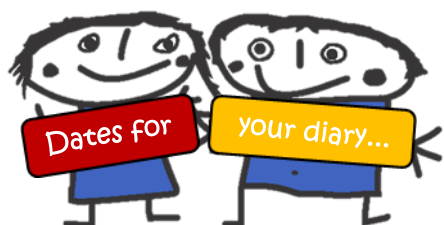

Year 1 (Classes 3, 4 & 5)

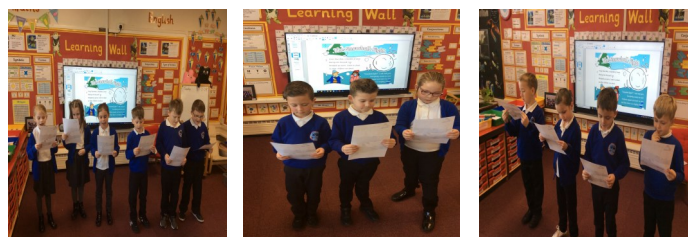
