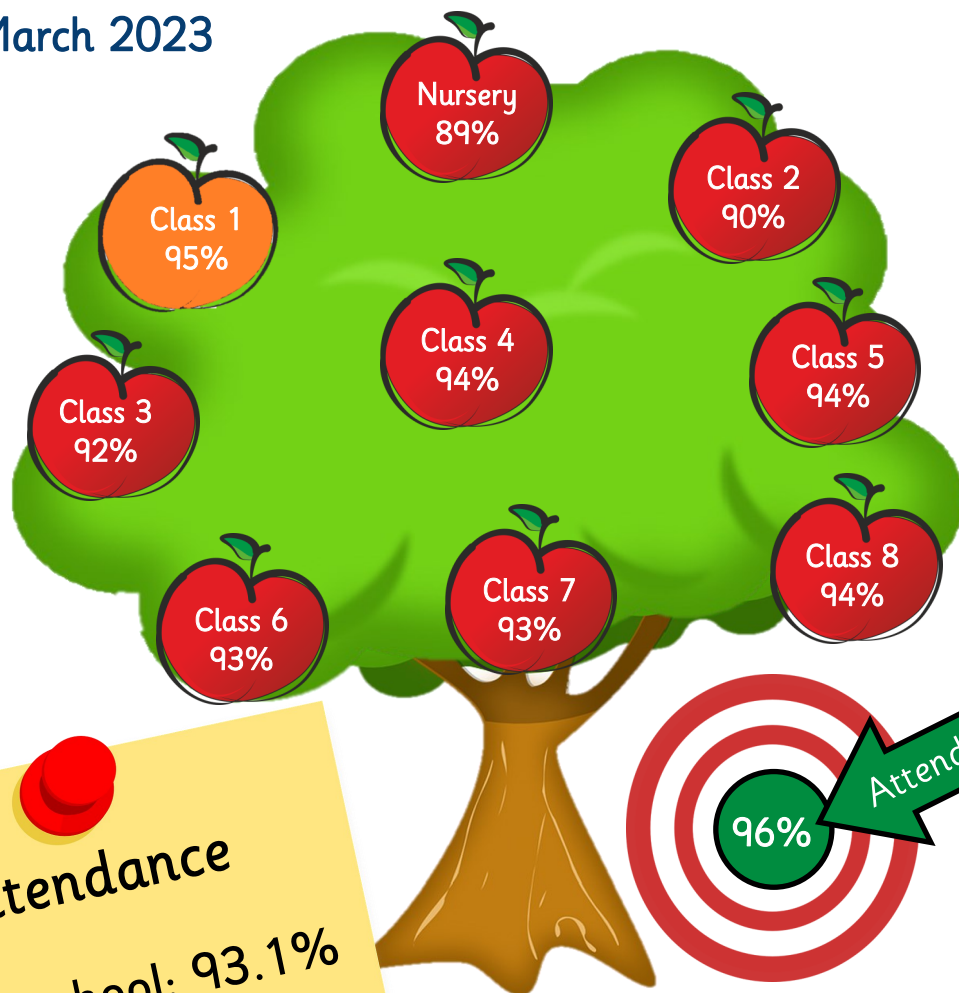


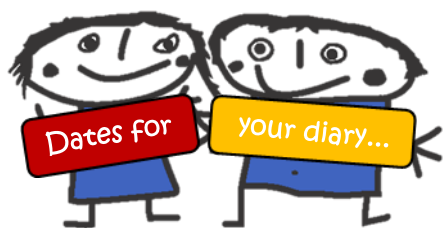
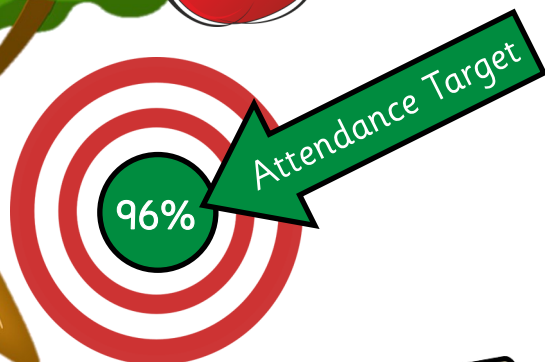

Thank you to all the parents and children who attended our Nursery Book and Bun session this week! We had a fantastic time exploring the different activities which were all book themed.



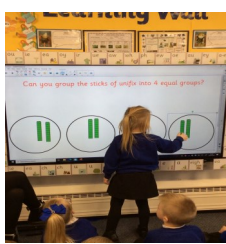
Reception (Classes 1 & 2)
