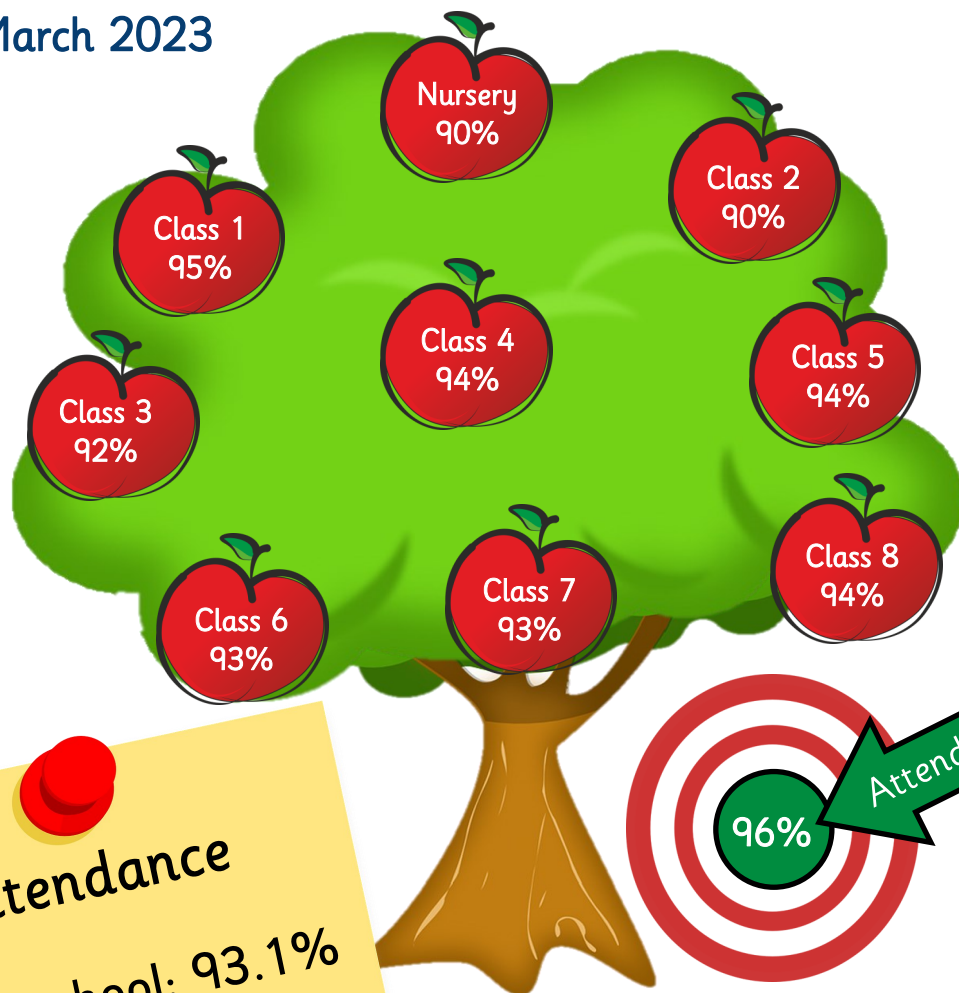


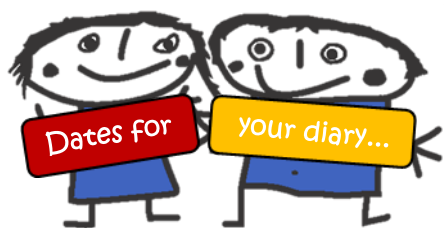
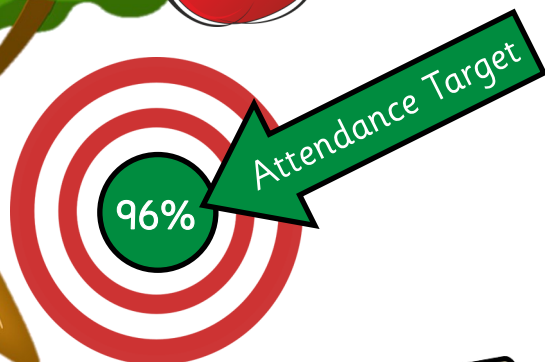

The Police came to visit Nursery this week with their Police van. The children learnt all about how the Police help us and keep us safe.

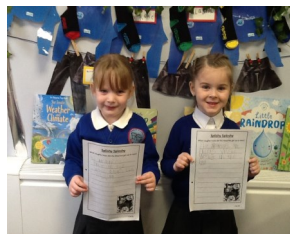
They really enjoyed sitting in the Police van and making the siren and lights work!

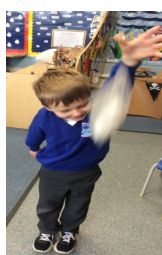
What budding authors we have in Reception!

In Year 2 this week the children had a great time celebrating 'Science Week' by taking part in a bridge building challenge.

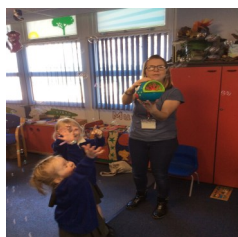
They used a range of different materials and worked together to see what weight their bridge could hold!
