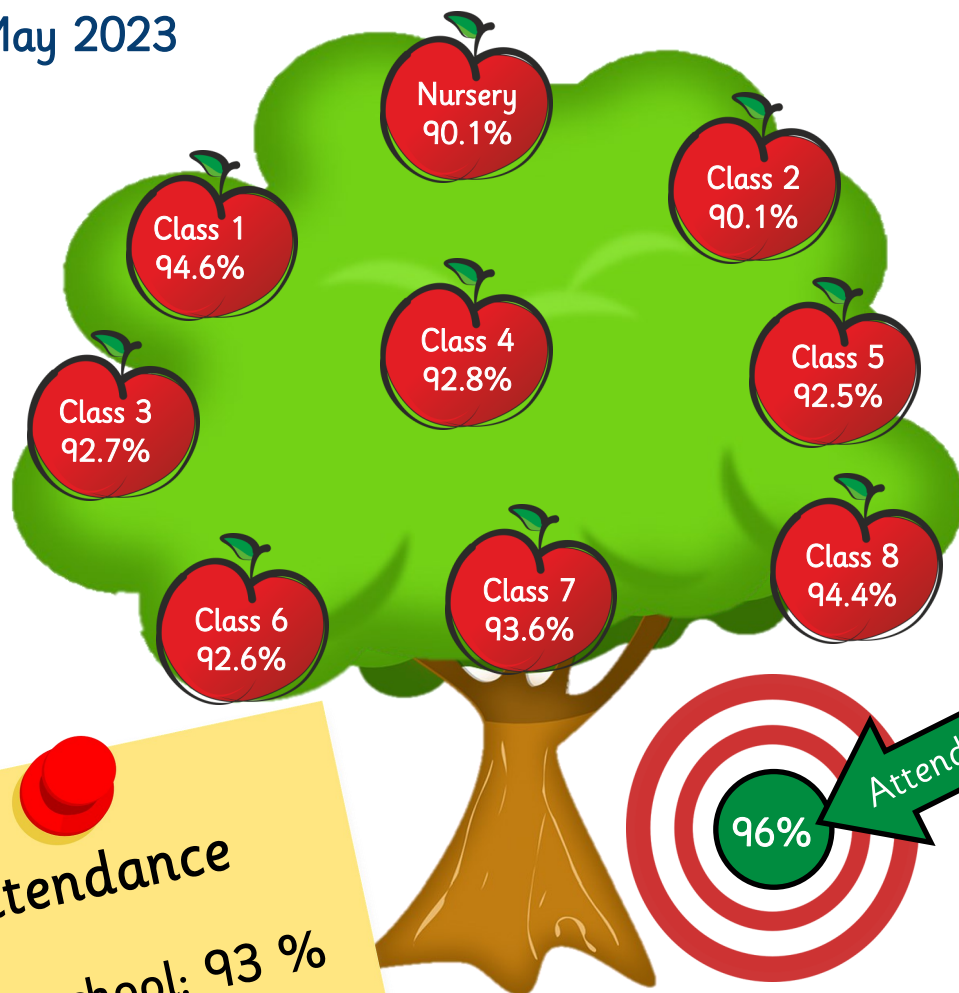


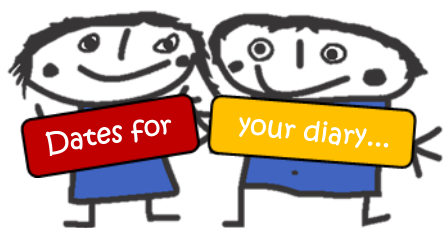
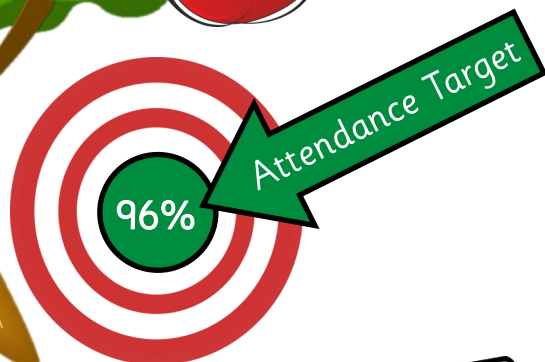

## Nursery

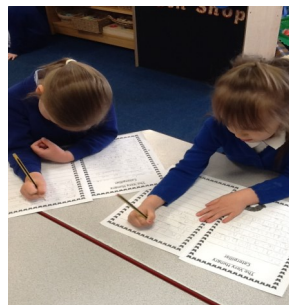
This week in Nursery the children have enjoyed planting cornflower seeds.
