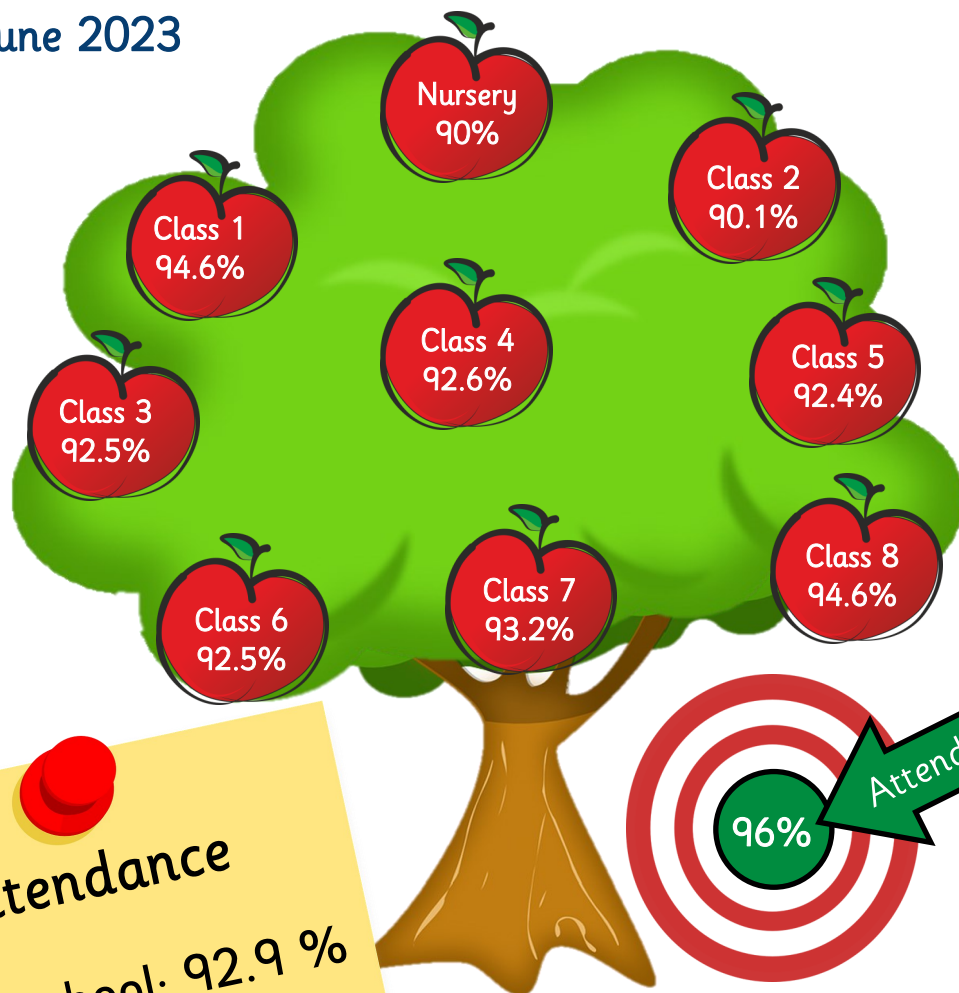


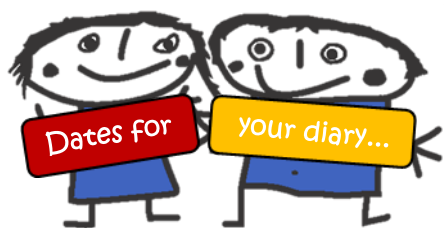
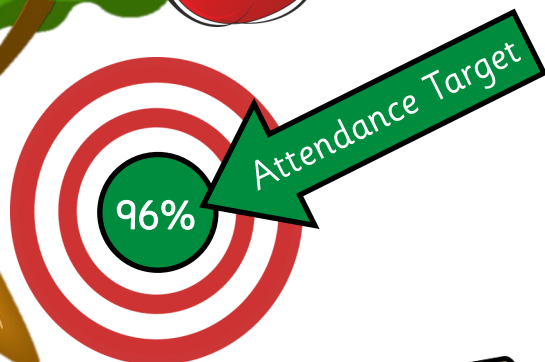

Reception (Classes 1 & 2)

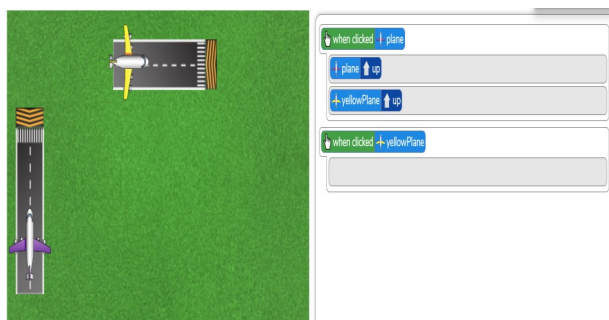
The children in Reception did an amazing job at remembering the names and values of coins when revisiting their learning of 'Money' this week.
