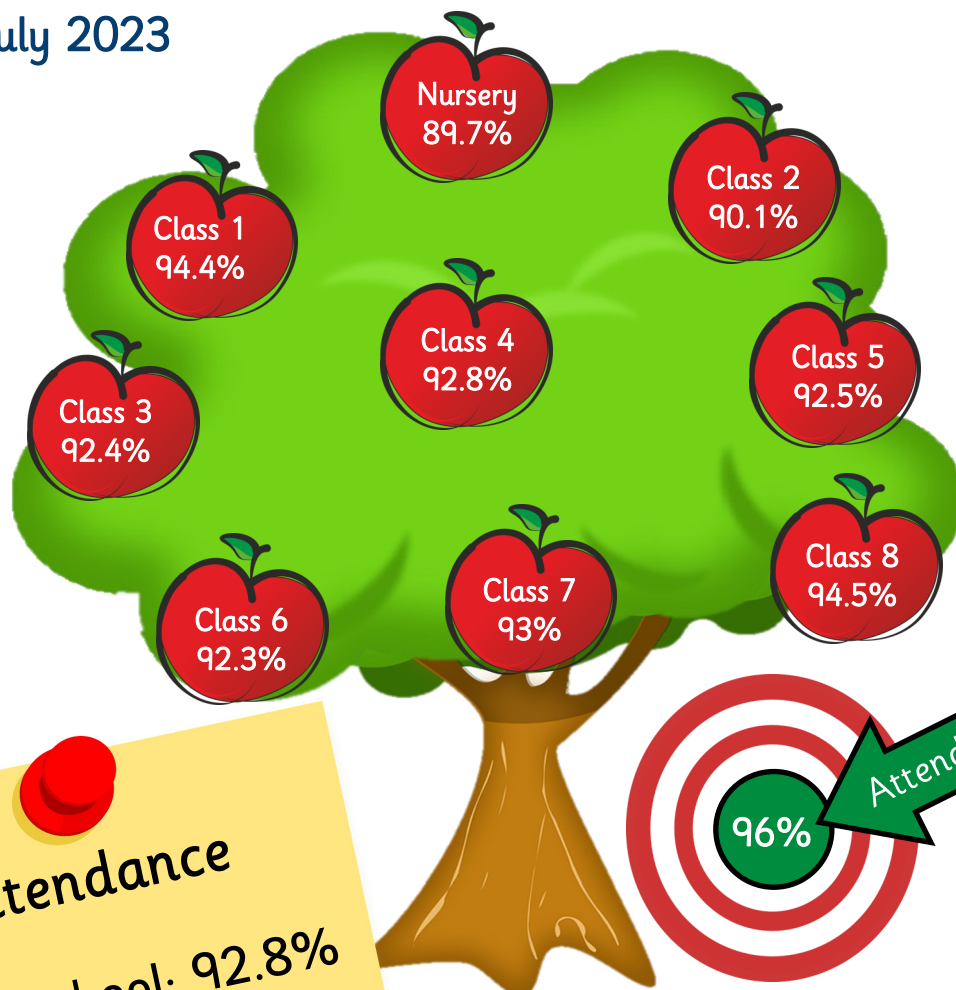


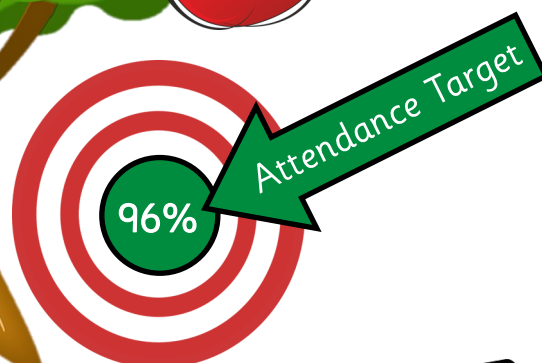

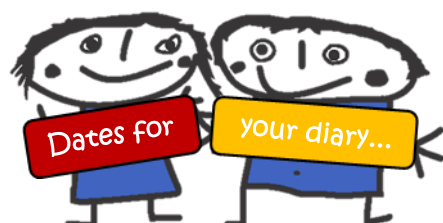

The children enjoyed looking back at our knowledge organisers, choosing their favourite and writing about the facts that they could remember.

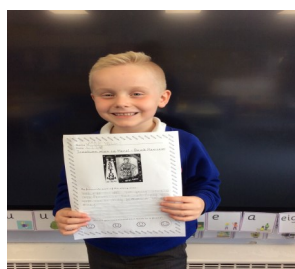
Well done everyone!
