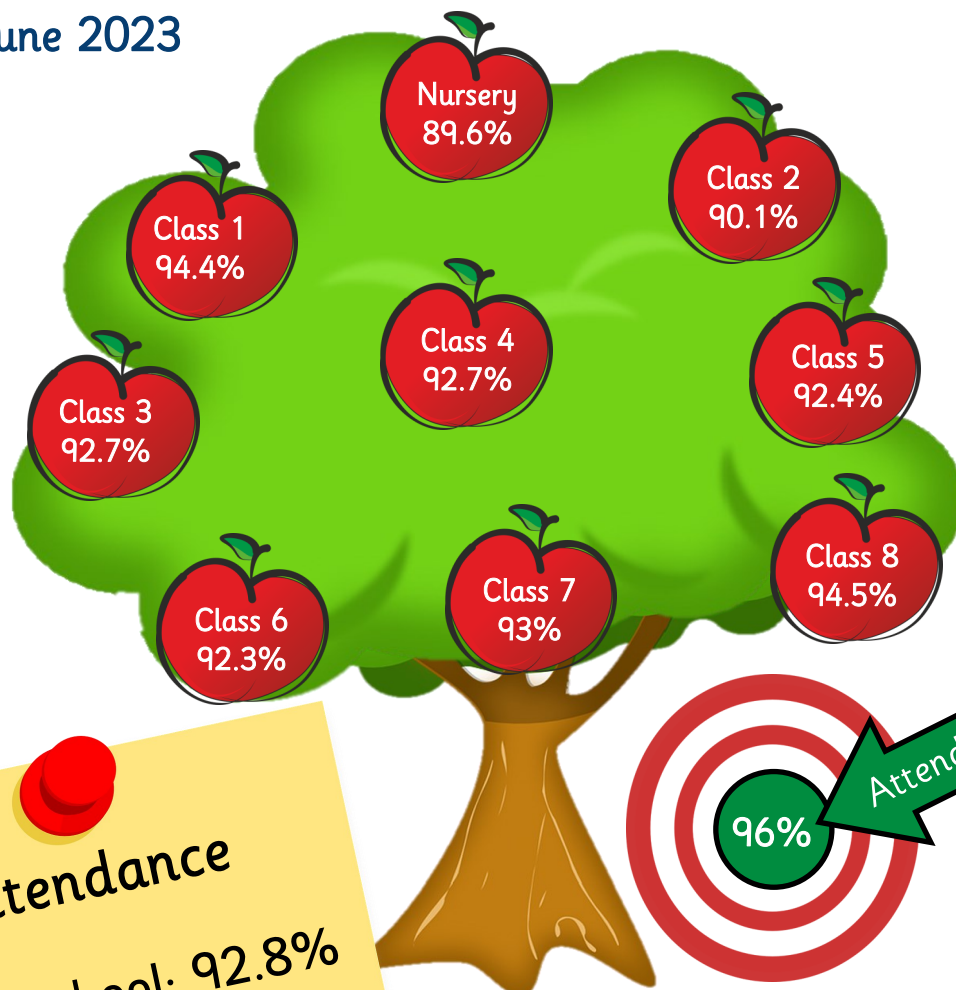


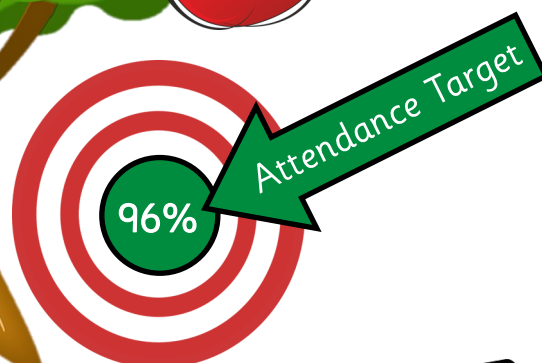

This week in Reception, we have been taking part in all the different challenges set for this year's 'Rowena Sports Week 2023'.

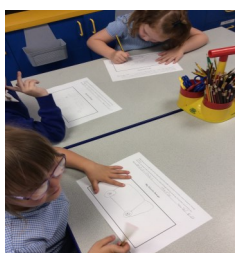
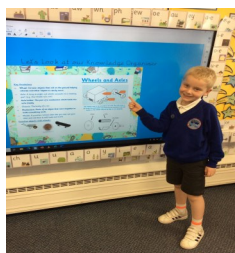
The children have loved all the sports from bowling, tennis and golf, to running through the obstacle course, all earning stamps for their certificates and points for their teams.



Year 1 (Classes 3, 4 & 5)

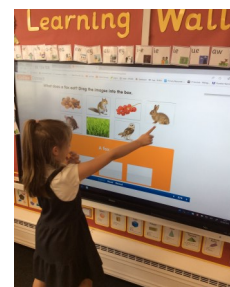
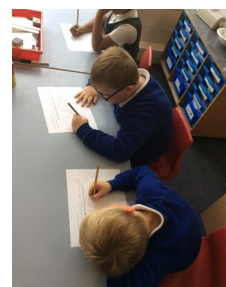
