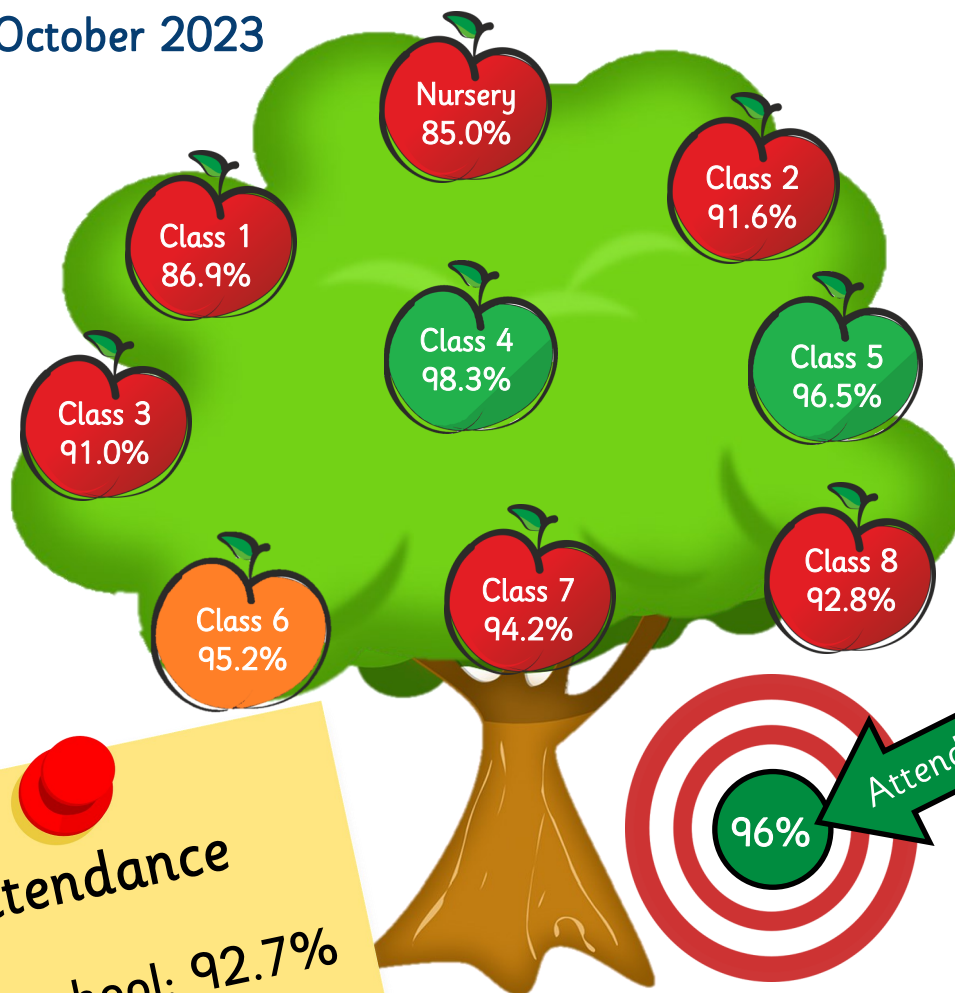

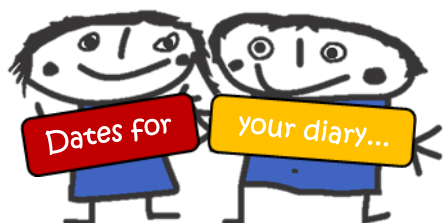


Attendance
