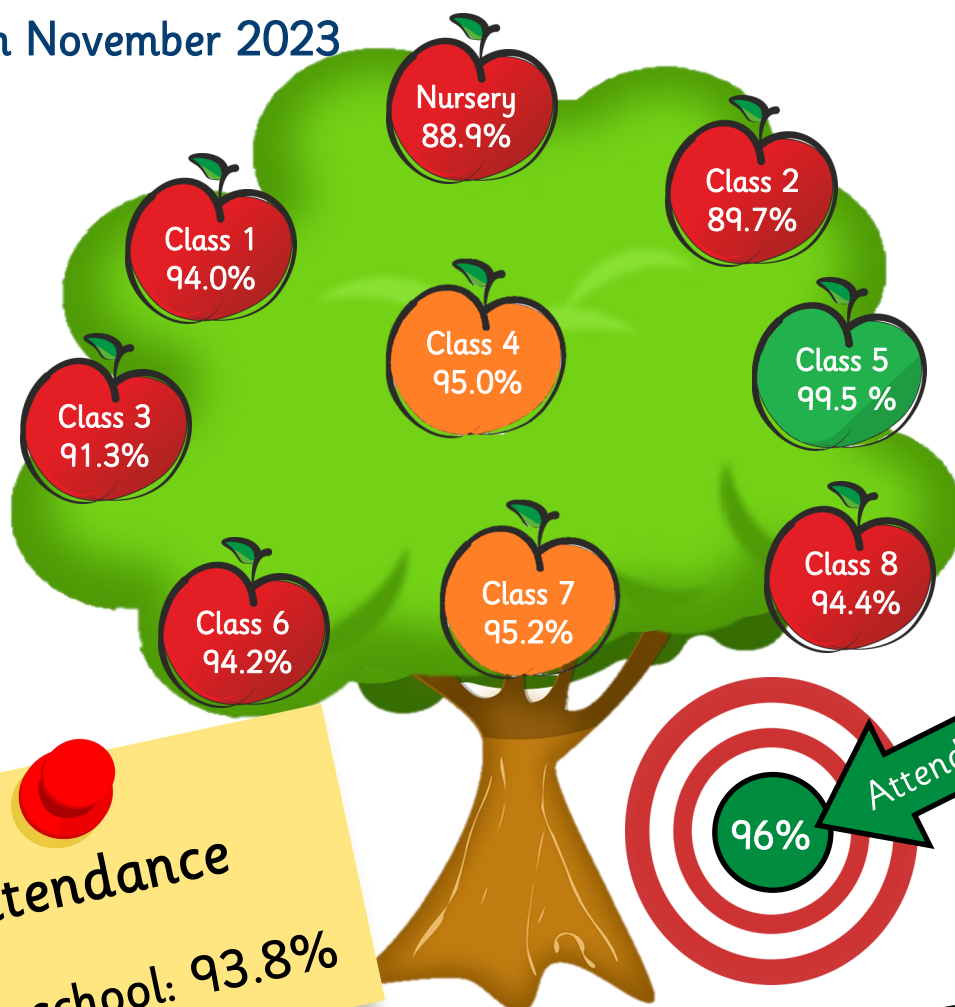




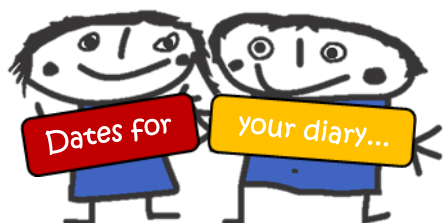

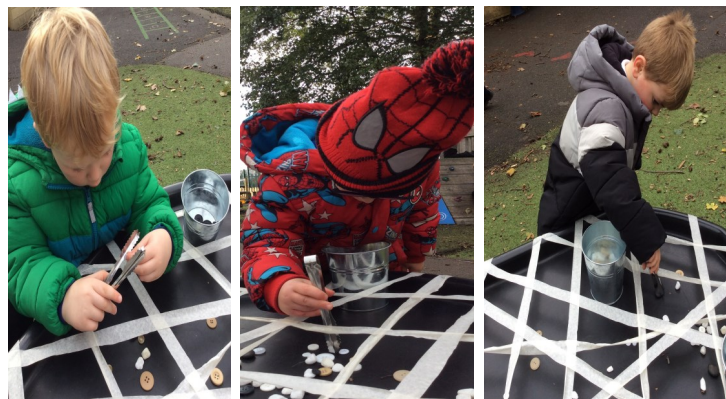
Nursery

The Nursery children have enjoyed learning about Number Puppy 3. Look at the fantastic triangle biscuits we have made with red icing and 3 chocolates on top!



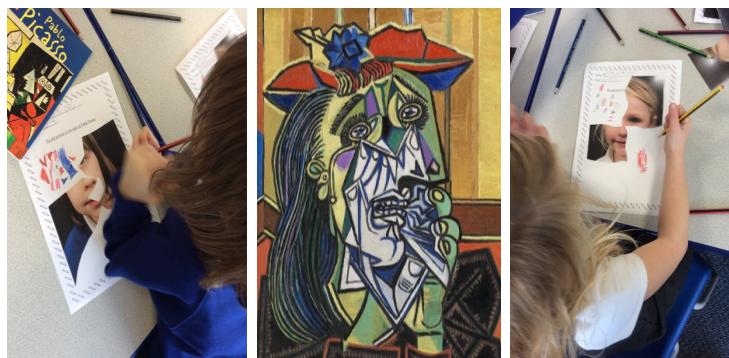
Reception (Classes 1 & 2)

This week in Reception, the children have enjoyed completing more of our exciting outdoor challenges. They did an amazing job and they can't wait to find out what the next challenge will be!



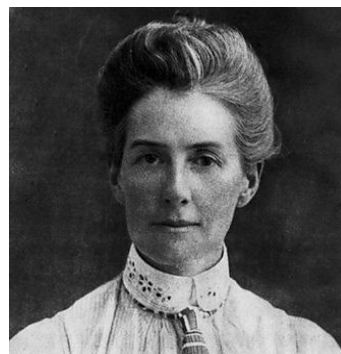
Year 1 (Classes 3, 4 & 5)
