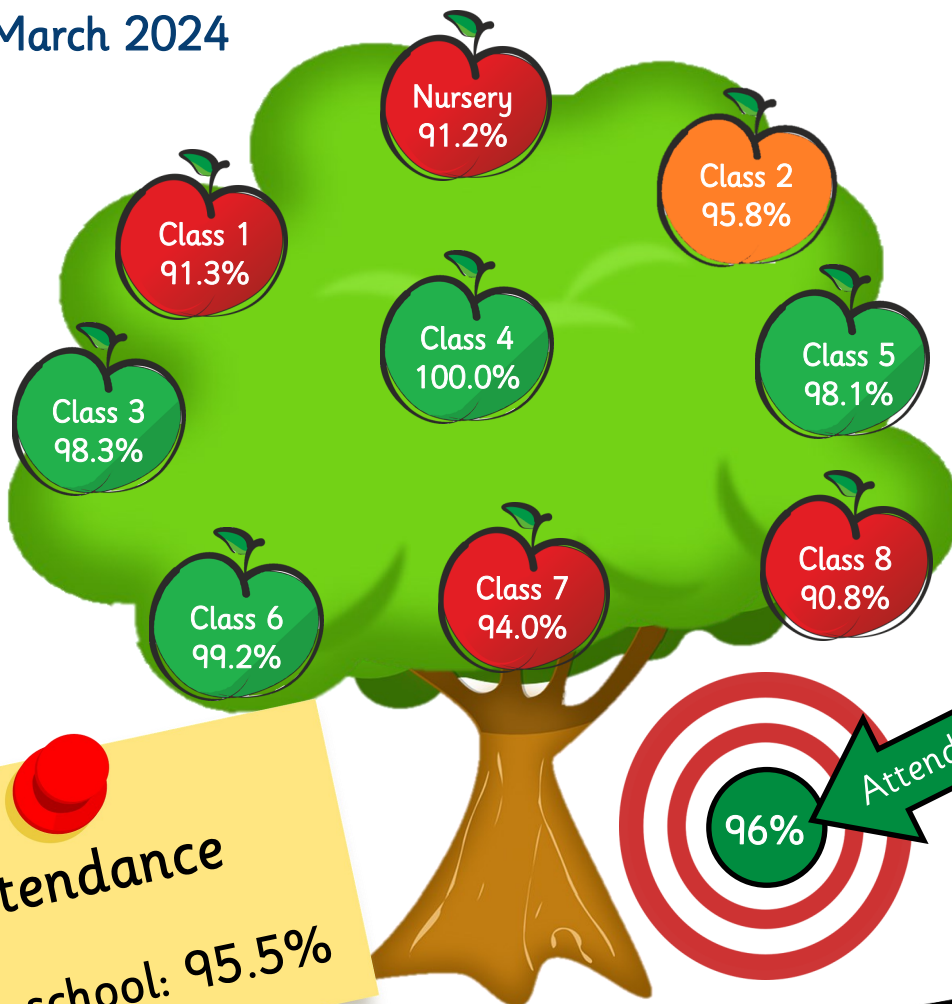

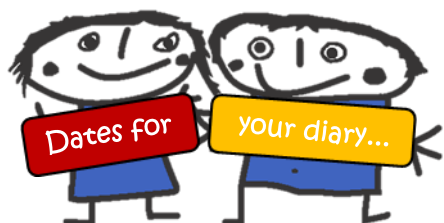

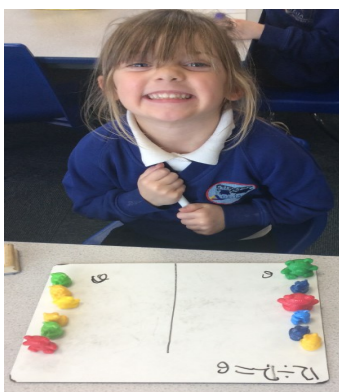
## Reception (Classes 1 & 2)

In Year 2 this week the children have been using the bar method to find a fraction of a quantity. They split the bar into different parts before sharing the numbers out equally.

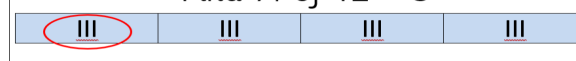
### The Bar Method

#### Fractions

Find  $\frac{1}{4}$  of 12 = 3
