Key Vocabulary

Fabric: Materials produced by weaving or knitting fibres.

Join: Connect two things together.

Glue: A sticky object/liquid that joins and holds materials together.

Staple: A short thin wire with bent ends that is punched through layers of thin material to fasten them together.

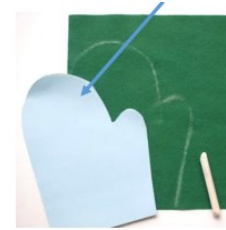
Decorate: Make something look more attractive by adding extra items or images to it.

Template: A pattern used as a guide for cutting.

There are many types of fabrics all made from different materials. They can be **shiny**, **soft**, **rough**, **dull** and **stretchy**. Some fabrics are easier to work with than others so you have to choose carefully.
